




- wifi and Sonos speakers for DIY playlists in barn (professional DJ sound system available for rent)
- strung lights in the barn
- a ceremony arch outside (fixed)
- trash disposal

for the organization, coordination and execution of the wedding we ask you to identify a pointperson or work with a professional day-of wedding coordinator to assure a good flow on the day of your wedding. hiring a professional coordinator is required for guest counts above 125. this person is responsible for:

- o creating & sticking to timelines
- o communicating with vendors
- o decorations and placement of personal items
- o logistics
