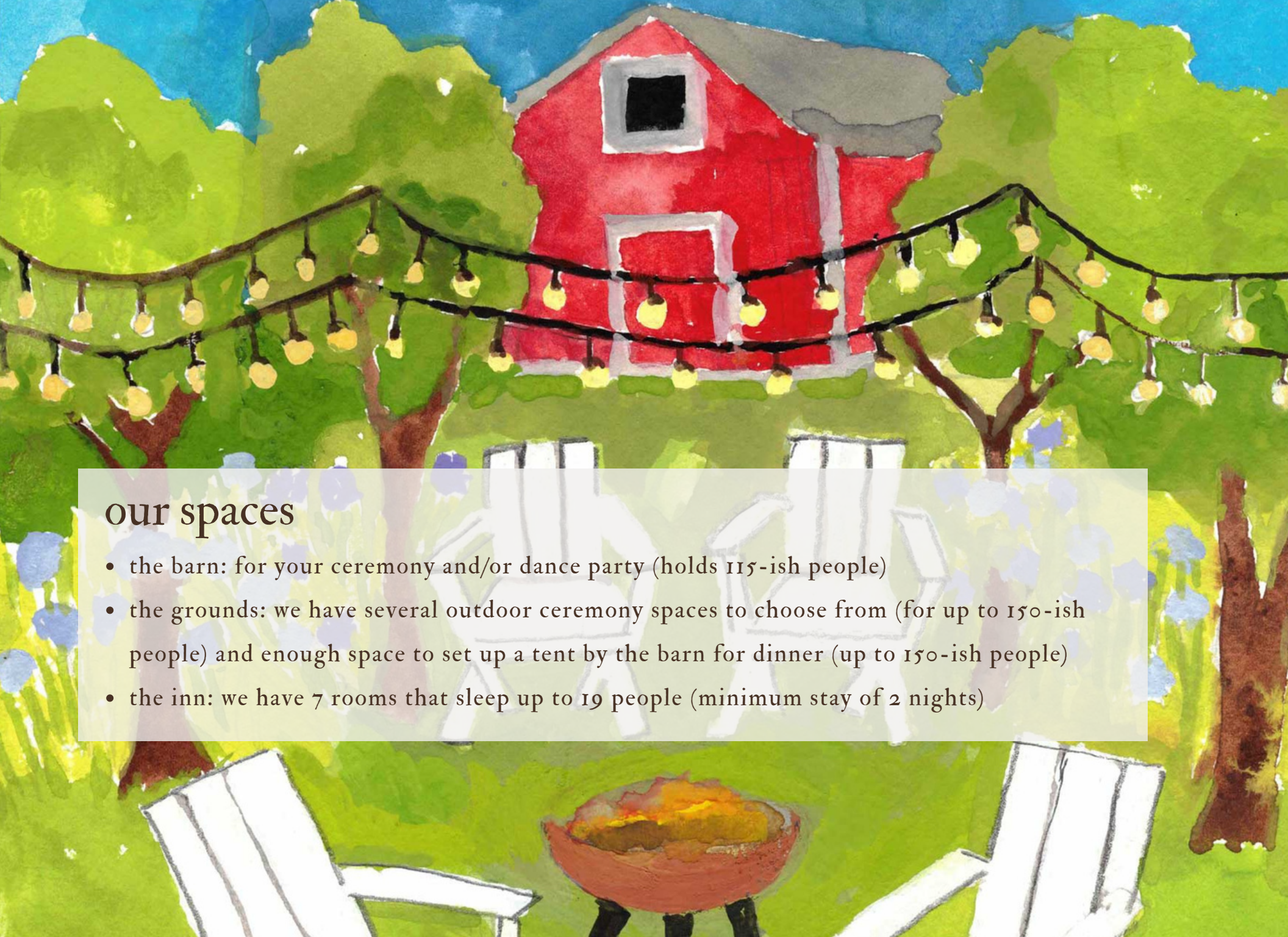

the area

we are nestled just outside the quaint town of bristol, vermont. our historic 18th-century town is remarkably vibrant and lined with cute shops, restaurants, a coffee shop, brewery, and much more. bristol is known for its warmth and unbeatable hospitality as well as being the gateway to the green mountains.

our spaces

- the barn: for your ceremony and/or dance party (holds 115-ish people)
- the grounds: we have several outdoor ceremony spaces to choose from (for up to 150-ish people) and enough space to set up a tent by the barn for dinner (up to 150-ish people)
- the inn: we have 7 rooms that sleep up to 19 people (minimum stay of 2 nights)

- parking

- 20 adirondack chairs
- PA system with microphones for your ceremony
- wifi and Sonos speakers for DIY playlists in barn (professional DJ sound system available for rent)
- strung lights in the barn
- a ceremony arch outside (fixed)
- trash disposal

wedding planning services

as a venue and caterer we got you covered for a flawless execution of all things venue and food related. we take responsibility for all logistics on our end, including:

- preparing our site (with amenities included in the venue fee)
- set-up of the ceremony site (chairs + PA system)
- set-up of tables and chairs for reception/dinner & table setting (if preferred)
- all catering related logistics

for the organization, coordination and execution of the wedding we ask you to identify a point-person or work with a professional day-of wedding coordinator to assure a good flow on the day of your wedding. hiring a professional coordinator is required for guest counts above 125. this person is responsible for:

- creating & sticking to timelines
- communicating with vendors
- decorations and placement of personal items
- logistics
